We would like to thank all those that supported us through the years. Special thanks to the Government of Alberta, the City of Brooks and the County of Newell for their ongoing support.


Finally, on behalf of our library family, our deepest gratitude to all our patrons and community members. You are the reason we do this. It is an honour to serve you all. Thank you!
