A Baffin Vacation, Love on Ice

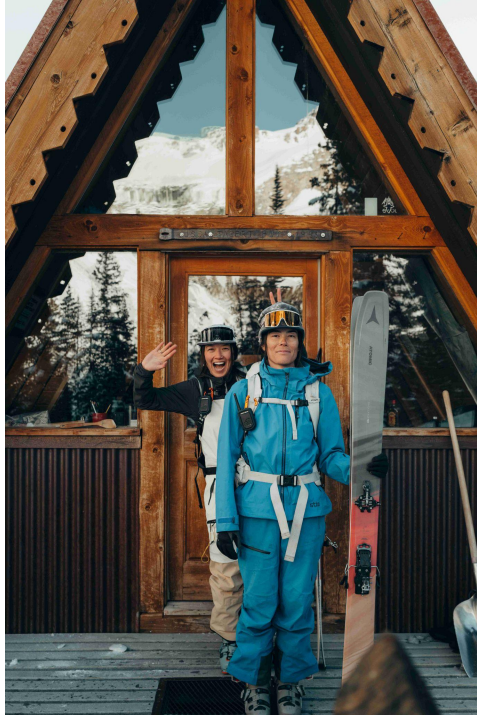
